

Dive Operations Intern (Spring 2017)

Internship Description:

At the South Carolina Aquarium, Dive Operations Interns will gain experience in all aspects of running an Aquarium Dive Safety Program. Interns will have the opportunity to be trained on Gear Inspections, Dive Team Management, Dive Shows, and Aquarium Husbandry of the Great Ocean Tank Exhibit. Interns will gain experience diving Full Face Masks, Surface Supply, Underwater Communications, and Reserve Air Systems.

This internship is geared towards those interested in Aquarium Husbandry and running a Dive Safety Program through an Aquarium, University, or Research facility.

Commitment Required:

- 30 hours per week (flexible)
- 6 month term (flexible)
- Desired start date: December 2016 / January 2017

Prerequisites:

- Preferred Rescue Scuba Certified or Profession Rating (DM, AI, Instructor etc.)
- At least 25 logged dives in varying conditions
- Prior CPR/AED/O2 certification preferred

Applicants must be dependable, have excellent communication skills, be able to regularly lift at least 50lbs, and be comfortable speaking with the public in formal and informal settings.

Applicants are expected to pass an AAUS physical, swim, and scuba skill test for the position.
