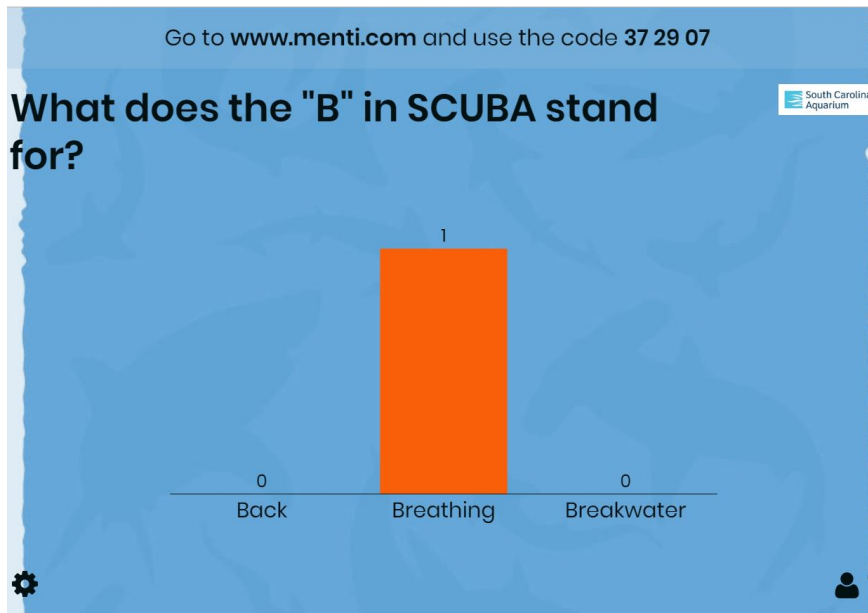
While audience is answering, **ask diver how many gallons are in the GOT**

Diver- 385,000 gallons

Confirm that the correct answer is 42 feet.

This is the deepest tank in North America. Let the audience know how deep you are at the window (~27 feet).

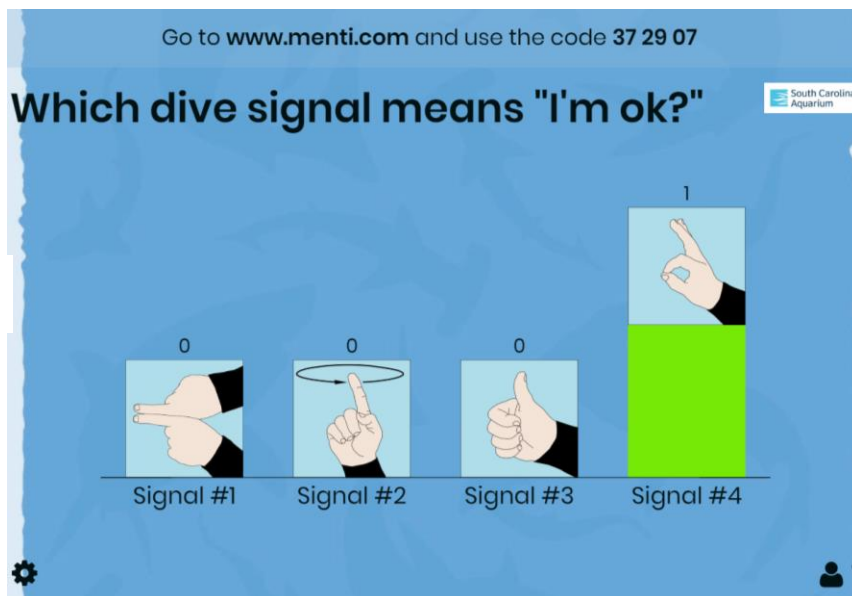
While audience is answering, ask diver what is required to dive in the GOT.

Diver- Advanced Open Water certification, frequent on-site safety trainings, and time commitment.

Confirm that the correct answer is Breathing.

SCUBA stands for self-contained underwater breathing apparatus.

While audience is answering, **ask diver about the equipment they are using to communicate today.**

Diver- I'm using a full face mask to communicate. If you follow the blue cord up to the surface, that's housing my microphone.

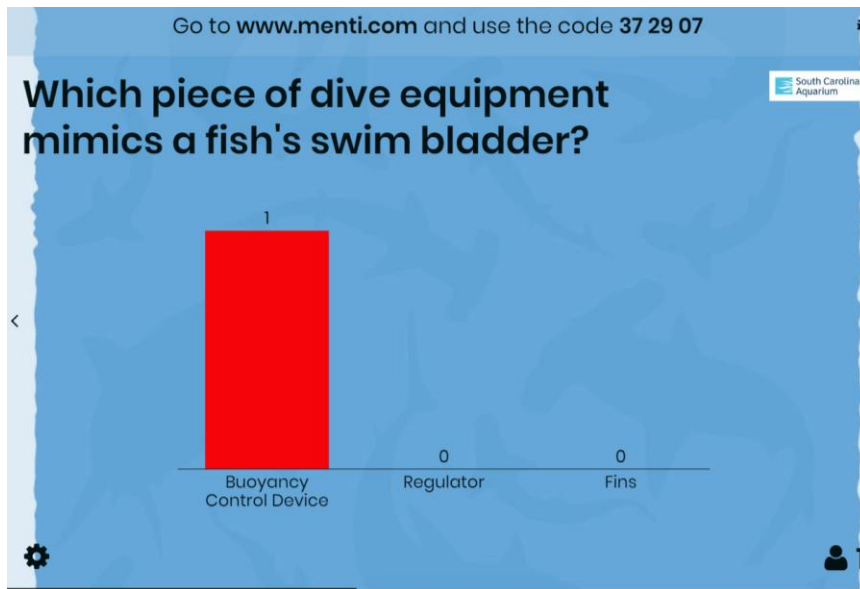
Educator- ask the audience to help you show the signs to the diver (since they can't see the screen).

Diver- tell us what the other signs mean after we show them to you. #1- find your buddy; #2 turn around; #3 surface

Confirm that the correct answer is Signal #4

SCUBA stands for self-contained underwater breathing

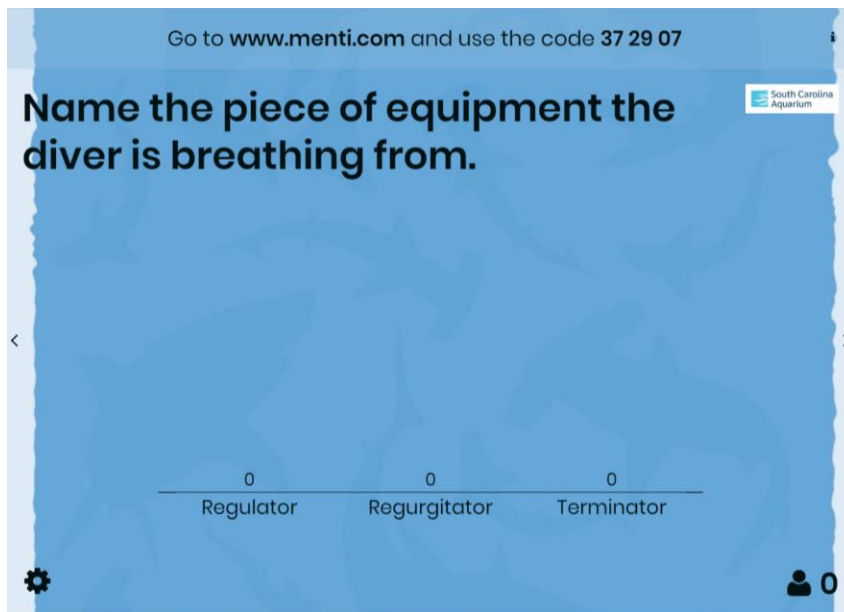
While audience is answering, **ask diver what a swim bladder is.**

Diver- the swim bladder is an air filled pocket that helps a fish to rise in the water.

Confirm that the correct answer is Buoyancy Control Device.

Diver may demonstrate putting air into the BCD and letting the air out.

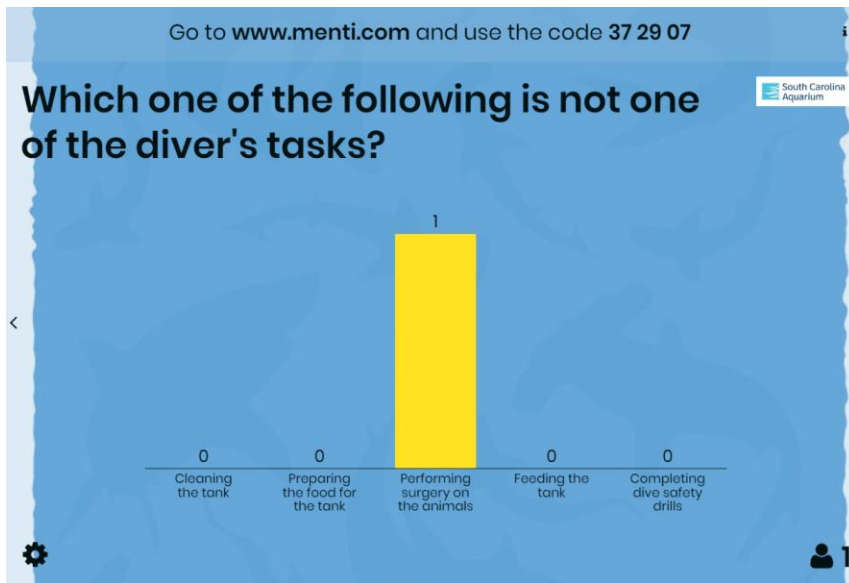
While audience is answering, **ask diver what the small tank on their side is.**

Diver- pony bottle filled with back up air as a safety precaution.

Confirm that the correct answer is Regulator.

Diver- regulator reduces the air pressure flowing out of the tank to comfortable breathing levels.

While audience is answering, ask who the other diver is.

Diver- that's my safety diver. We never dive alone in the GOT. They help to keep an eye on my equipment and animals like Caretta.

Confirm that the correct answer is performing surgery.

Educator- That's a job for our veterinary team, but our divers do so much to care for the GOT.

While audience is answering, ask diver how they feed the GOT.

Diver- Using target feeding and broadcast feeding, we are able to distribute 60 pounds of food to the GOT every day.

Confirm that the correct answer is 7 gallons of waste every single day.
