When Aquarium workers take care of animals, they clean their tanks, feed them, watch their behavior and teach about them.




Some Aquarium workers work behind desks.

Some Aquarium workers carry animals like turtles for you to touch.






Some Aquarium workers work at the Touch Tank and will help you safely touch animals like sea stars.
