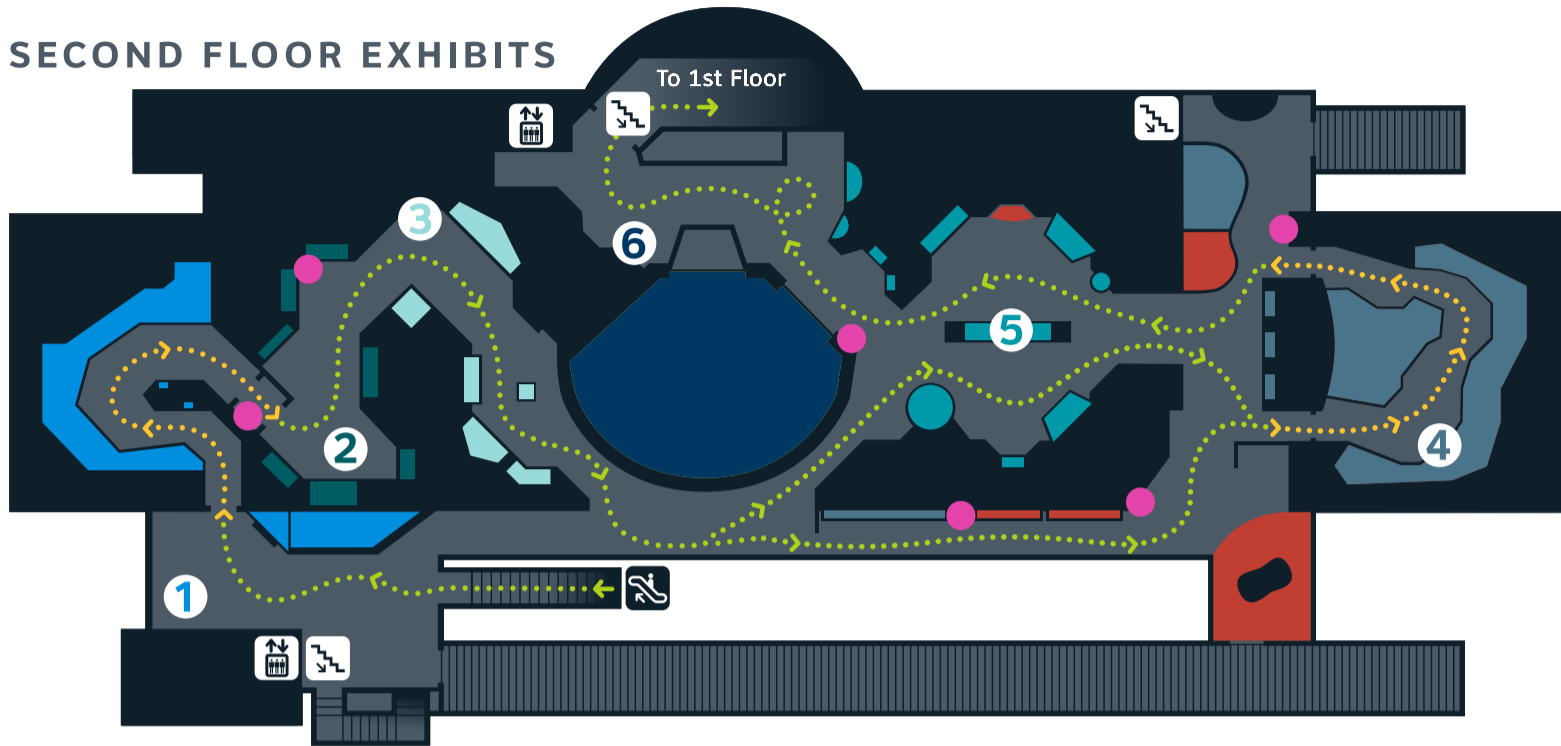

**2 PIEDMONT**

Visit our American kestrel and see the rich and varied aquatic life supported by streams, rivers and man-made reservoirs.

**3 COASTAL PLAIN**

Travel through the Coastal Plain, home to the Aquarium's more intimidating residents, including American alligators and snakes.

**4 SALTMARSH AVIARY**

See coastal birds up close and observe terrapins and stingrays in their natural habitat.

**5 COAST**

From seahorses to lionfish, meet the creatures that inhabit our coastal waters and discover how you can make a Good Catch with sustainable seafood.

**6 OCEAN**

Pretend you're a scuba diver in the 42-foot-deep Great Ocean Tank. See a loggerhead sea turtle, sharks and more than 500 fish!
